### Fake building: Claude wrote 3k lines instead of `import pywikibot`

Claude generated thousands of lines of code for a Python script, only to realize it should have simply imported the existing Pywikibot library. This error highlights a critical risk in AI-assisted coding: models often hallucinate complex solutions instead of recognizing standard tools, leading to massive inefficiency and wasted effort. Developers must remain vigilant to ensure AI outputs are actually useful rather than just impressively long.

You can now run Large Language Models directly from shell scripts using a shebang line, enabling tasks like generating images or performing calculations with tool calls. This approach simplifies automation by allowing LLMs to execute Python functions or query databases straight from the command line. It matters because it bridges the gap between conversational AI and practical scripting, making it easier to build self-contained, executable workflows without complex setup.
